


#### Vacation Care Bookings Open

The garden at Wilston Kids Care is a thoughtfully crafted therapeutic space dedicated to co-regulation. Here, nature and mindfulness practices intertwine, nurturing the emotional well-being of every child.

Within this sensory-rich environment, children embark on a calming exploration of textures, smells, and sounds. This transforms gardening into a joyful physical and mental activity, contributing to an improved mood and overall well-being.

Mindfulness naturally blossoms as children immerse themselves in the present moment, experiencing a sense of calm and relaxation.

At WKC, we've tapped into natures innate ability to reduce stress and anxiety by introducing a new sign to our garden, which guides children with five easy prompts:

- 1. Focus on one thing you can taste.
- 2. Think about two things you can smell.
- 3. Find three things you can hear.
- 4. Discover four things to touch and think about how they feel.
- 5.Name five things you can see.

As part of the Containers for Change initiative, we've been diligently collecting eligible cans in our distinctive green containers for change bins. All funds that are raised are directed towards our community garden or acquiring new equipment for the children.

Additionally, we're active participants in the Nespresso coffee pod recycling program. After enjoying our coffee, the used pods undergo a transformation. They're sent to an industrial composting facility where they become nutrient rich compost, contributing to environmental sustainability. The aluminium from the pods is recycled and repurposed into brand-new aluminium products.

These initiatives are part of our commitment to instilling a sense of responsibility for our planet in the children.
