Your role is pivotal in shaping our children's lives and we appreciate you today and every day. Your continuous support, resilience, and nurturing love is something we honour and celebrate.

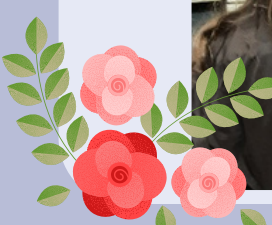

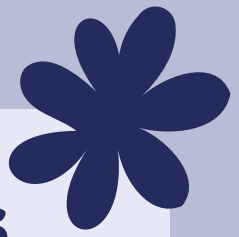
## Hero's Journey
