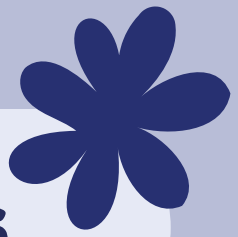

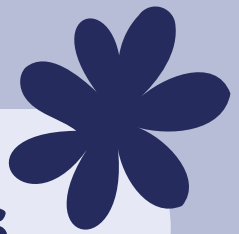

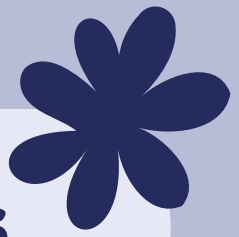
Our Containers for Change branded bins are located on the Wilston Kids Care stage area and in the WKC Community Garden area. You can add to these bins even if you don't attend Wilston Kids Care as we want this to be a community initiative that supports our community garden that everyone enjoys. Every container counts! Once our bins are full, the Containers for Change collection team will pick up the contents of our bins and sort them into material types before they get transported to be processed. The containers are then prepared for recycling at the processing facility before recyclers purchase the processed materials which they transform into new containers and other products.
