# Important Reminders

The Wilston Kids Care Vacation Care experience is designed to provide your child with a fun and engaging opportunity where they can enjoy their school holidays and learn along the way. Vacation Care offers your child a variety of opportunities to develop social skills, build relationships and engage in experiences unique to Outside School Hours Care.

During Vacation Care, the children have the ability to engage in multi-age play during the day. Siblings can choose to play with one another if they wish. The Vacation Care Program is designed to cater for all children's developmental abilities, and interests and is child focused to cater for an array of ages from Prep to Grade 6 (4-12 yrs).

## Sun Safety Reminders

The Service has a strict Sun Safe Policy which must be adhered to whilst at care. Staff and children are required to wear sun safe broad brimmed hats that protect their face, neck and ears. When outdoors, staff and children will wear sun safe clothing that covers as much of the skin as possible (especially the shoulders, back and stomach).

Sunscreen is supplied at the Service and is applied throughout each session. We strongly encourage parents to apply to their child upon arrival or before they attend Wilston Kids Care.

### WHAT NOT TO WEAR

- Midriff, crop, singlet tops or sleeveless dresses that don't provide enough sun protection and therefore are not permitted.
- Baseball caps or visors do not provide enough sun protection and therefore are not permitted. Please ensure your child wears a brimmed hat.



## What to Bring to Vacation Care

When attending Vacation Care, please make sure to bring the following things:

- Closed in shoes (No sandals, thongs or wheelie shoes)
- Spare clothes (No singlets)
- Sufficient Morning and Afternoon tea
- Broad Brimmed Hat (No Caps)
- Individual Water bottle.

**Please make sure all these items are labelled with your child's name.**

## Meal Times During Vacation Care



At Wilston Kids Care we encourage a healthy lifestyle by engaging children in physical activities and discussions around nutrition.

Breakfast (6:45 am - 7:45 am) and Lunch (only) are provided at Vacation Care each day. Families are required to supply their child's morning and afternoon tea. Please provide sufficient portion sizes as children are very active in their learning and leisure during the Vacation Care Program.

## Cancellation Notice Period 2 weeks (14 days) for Vacation Care

If you need to cancel a Vacation Care booking you can do so with a minimum of 2 weeks (14 days) notice in writing via email to our administration team.

Please be advised that if your cancellation occurs within the 14-day period, prior to your booking, charges will apply. These are approved terms and conditions of entry to Vacation Care and are not negotiable.

If you have not provided us with the adequate notice period, we ask that you then mark your child absent on Xplor and the normal fees will apply.

# Incursion Information

During the Vacation Care period, incursions are carefully scheduled to occur **between 10:00am and 3:00pm each day**. While exact session times may vary depending on the provider and the nature of the activity, there is a **strong preference for 10:00am start times wherever possible**. This scheduling approach is intentional and reflects the typical attendance patterns of our service, where the majority of children are dropped off before 9:00am and collected after 3:00pm. By planning incursions within this window, we aim to maximise the opportunity for as many children as possible to participate, regardless of their family's individual drop-off and pick-up routines.

**Incursions are organised according to cohort groupings**, and this information is noted on the relevant day within the Vacation Care program. Some incursions are designed specifically for Junior children (Prep–Year 2), some are tailored for Senior children (Years 3–6), and others are structured as whole-service experiences suitable for all age groups. Families are encouraged to check the program carefully so they are aware of which activities apply to their child's age group on any given day.

**All incursions operate as time-limited sessions** rather than all-day events. Most external providers attend for a defined period within the 10:00am–3:00pm window, rather than remaining onsite for the entire five hours. To support participation, educators make multiple announcements and reminders throughout the day, invite children at appropriate times, and actively encourage involvement so that no child misses out simply because they were engaged elsewhere at the time.

While educators strongly promote participation and aim to ensure all children are aware of the opportunities available, in most cases **attendance at incursions remains the child's choice**. Children may choose whether or not to join the session when it is offered, unless the activity requires pre-allocation for safety or capacity reasons. Our approach balances encouraging children to try new experiences with respecting their autonomy, comfort levels, and current interests on the day.

## Featured Activity Information

Each day of our Vacation Care program includes a set of FEATURED activities - our special, highlight experiences for the day. These are divided into up to three sections to ensure they are age-appropriate and engaging for everyone: Prep–Grade 2, Grade 3–6, and All Grades. Children can participate in the activities designed specifically for their cohort. In addition to the featured activities, a range of other themed activities will be available throughout the day, along with supervised free play both indoors and outdoors.
