When:	<p>Prep—Grade 2: Thursday 15 December 2022, Thursday 5 January 2023, Wednesday 11 January 2023, Thursday 19 January 2023</p> <p>Grade 3—Grade 6: Wednesday 14 December 2022, Wednesday 4 January 2023, Tuesday 10 January 2023, Monday 16 January 2023</p>
Destination:	Wilston State School Swimming Pool 11 Primrose St, Grange QLD 4051
Reason for the activity:	The children are given the opportunity to swim in the Wilston State School Pool as part of our Vacation Care Program. This activity helps the children to keep cool during the warmer months and helps them to develop their confidence in and around the water.
Method of Transport:	Walking
Educator to Child Ratio:	The ratio of Prep children is 1 educator to 5 children. The ratio for children in Grades 1-6 is 1 educator to 10 children. This will be adjusted according to the children's swimming ability. Wilson Kids Care will have educators both in and out of the pool to actively supervise the swimming.
Estimated number of Children per group:	30
Children must wear and bring:	<p>Children are to bring sun safe swimmers, including a sun shirt or "rashie", and towel for this activity (goggles optional). As WKC do not have these items to supply children who don't bring them, if these items are forgotten, the children will not be able to participate.</p> <p>As advised in the WKC sun safety policy children will be provided sun screen, however children must have/provide a sun shirt/rash shirt to be able to participate.</p>

Proposed Activities:	<p>Wilston Kids Care children will have the opportunity to swim in the Wilston State School pool, as part of our Vacation Care program. There will be a range of water activities on each of our swimming days, such as, relaxing on pool floats, Marco Polo, and water relay races.
