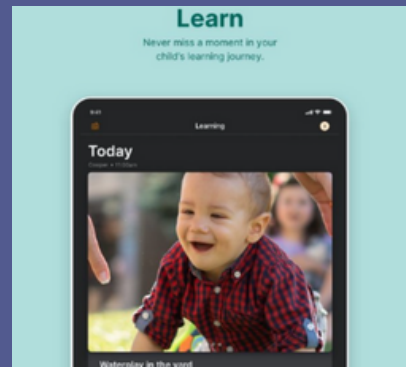

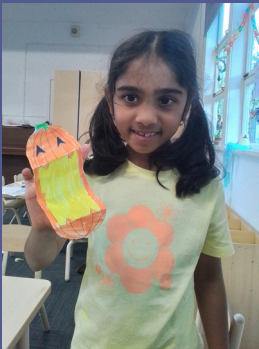

We are very excited to share a wonderful milestone from one of our Wilston Kids Care children. This talented child has recently co-illustrated a children's book with her mum, who is also the author. Their beautiful story follows a young girl named Love as she navigates the first day back at school, finds comfort in small treasures, celebrates her cultural traditions, and discovers that the simplest moments can become the most meaningful.

Emergency Drills

Last week at Wilston Kids Care we completed our 3 monthly Emergency Drills, with a Fire Evacuation Drill during Before School Care on Monday and a Lockdown Drill on Friday afternoon.

As an OSHC service, we are required to conduct emergency drills every three months. These regular practices help ensure that both children and educators know exactly what to do in an emergency, allowing us to respond calmly, confidently and safely. By rehearsing our procedures, we help children build a sense of security and awareness, supporting them to feel prepared without fear.



These drills also support our commitment to the National Quality Standards, particularly Quality Area 2 (Children's Health & Safety) and Quality Area 7 (Governance & Leadership). Regular emergency practice ensures we maintain high safety standards, review our procedures, and continuously improve how we protect and support the wellbeing of every child in our care. Thank you to all our educators and children for participating so calmly and responsibly during this week's drills.
